3	Section 11.e)	<p>i) It is located on a property in <del>the P, M1, C2, C3, C4, C6, C7, C8 or C9</del> <u>Park and Institutional (P), Industrial (M), and Commercial (C)</u> zones.</p>	<p>– Removing direct reference to particular zones in the Zoning Bylaw to avoid reference to obsolete zones.</p>										
4	Section 11.f)	<p>One Multiple User Sign is permitted on property zoned <del>C3 or C4 or M1 or C9</del> <u>as Service Commercial, Corridor Commercial, or Light Industrial</u>, provided that:</p>	<p>– Removing direct reference to particular zones in the Zoning Bylaw to avoid reference to obsolete zones.</p>
