RE: LONG RANGE FACILITY PLAN CONSULTATION

Trustees will be provided with an overview of the consultation that has taken place to date in relation to the Long Range Facility Plan and the Recommendations below:

1. Address the over capacity of Merritt Bench Elementary by pursuing a 50 student expansion.
2. Complete a needs assessment and potentially apply for Childcare BC Funding to construct daycare centres in both Princeton and Merritt.
3. Support capital expenditures and reduce costs through a review of surplus properties and the sale of prioritized surplus properties.
4. Complete a consultation process to gather information for the potential relocation of Kengard Learning Centre, Maintenance, IT and District Administration to Coquihalla Middle School for a target date of September 2022.
