# 3.1 Tourism Merritt and Merritt & Nicola Valley Destination Marketing Society - Joint Presentation

Will George, representing Tourism Merritt and Amber Papou, representing the Merritt and Nicola Valley Destination Marketing Society (MNVDMS) jointly presented on options for potentially setting up a Municipal and Regional District Tax in the City of Merritt.

Will and Amber provided an overview of the state of tourism in Merritt, including the contributions of Tourism Merritt and MNVDMS, acknowledging successes and challenges facing the sector. They also discussed the difference between a voluntary tourism levy and the Municipal and Regional District Tax.

Lastly, Amber presented a recommendation that MNVDMS be recognized as a DMO and be designated as the eligible entity for the purposes of collecting the MRDT tax, subject to a number of conditions.
